2014 had the NYCity Slickers on the move from one continent to another as they traveled from their New York City home base to Norway. In September, they embarked on a 2 week tour to Norway sponsored in part by the U.S. Embassy in Oslo, the Nordkapp Film Festival, and the Finnmark Fylkeskommune. The tour kicked-off the North Cape Film Festival and included sold-out concerts at Perleporten, Klimpt Live, Kampen Bistro, Bryggerhuset Syd Halden and a gospel concert in Honningsvåg. In addition to their tour concerts, the Slickers gave workshops on bluegrass/Americana roots music culminating in a concert with the Honningsvåg Blandakor Choir and Finnmark Opera Company.
